“ Maw-maw,

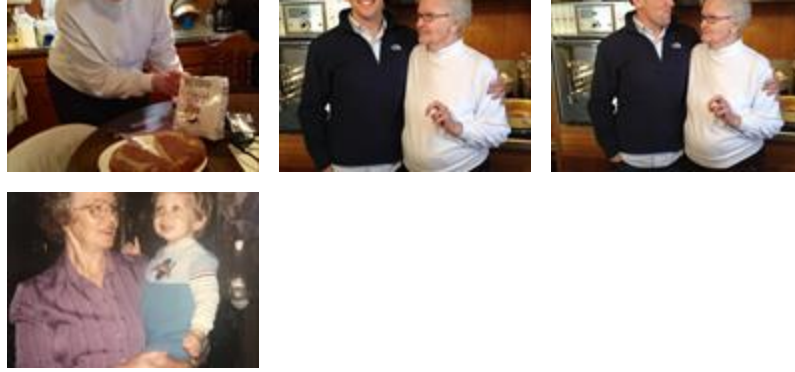
