Nina Weed Meeks of Guntersville, Alabama, passed away on Tuesday, December 12, at the age of 88. Nina was born on November 19, 1935, in Mansfield, Louisiana to Asa Clyde Weed and Clarice Ethridge Weed, the seventh of twelve children.
